<p>Biography</p> <p>Choose one of the following famous naturalists: David Attenborough, Jane Goodall or Charles Darwin. Write a biography about their lives, focusing on their work in nature.</p>	<p>Persuasive letter</p> <p>Write a persuasive letter to Mrs White, describing what we could do as a school to be more environmentally friendly (e.g. better recycling, etc), and why we should be doing this.</p>	<p>Story time</p> <p>Write a story set in the rainforest. This could be about an ancient Maya tribe, or about someone stranded in a rainforest, like in our class text, The Explorer.</p>
<p>Where in the World?</p> <p>Research and locate rainforests across the world on a map. Choose one of these rainforests to create a fact file about.</p>	<p>Amazing Animals!</p> <p>Choose an animal that lives in the rainforest. Create a presentation about this animal (this could be a poster or a PowerPoint presentation), thinking about what special features the animal has that helps it to survive in the rainforest.</p>	<p>Free write!</p> <p>Write a text of your choice on a topic of your choice.
