For any that link to our topic, you may want to wait until we've learned about it in school or do some research before you begin writing. When you have completed the activity, please put a cross through it.

We will continue to learn spellings at school and will use these during dictated sentences throughout the week. You will find the spelling rules we will cover this term on the back of this sheet. *Spelling Frame* will still be available for the children to log onto to practise the appropriate spellings.

Quiz Create a quiz about our Space topic. You could include questions about the different planets in our solar system. Include at least eight questions in your quiz. Make sure you prepare the answers separately.	Word search Choose one of the spelling rules we will be learning this half term and create your own wordsearch. Don't forget to write a list of the words at the bottom. See if someone can complete your wordsearch at home.	Letter Neil Armstrong was the first man to set foot on the moon. What would you like to know about the experience he had? Write a letter to him asking about the moon landing.
Fantasy story Write a story based on a journey into space. Structure your story to have an opening, build up, problem, resolution and ending. Think of the characters in your story and how they feel at different parts of the story.	Song time! Write a poem or a song based on space. Use your imagination and your knowledge of the topic to help you. Begin by writing down a bank of vocabulary such as nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs related to space. Try to include figurative language in your work.	Advert Write a job advert for an astronaut. What kind of skills and interests do you think you would need to be an astronaut? What kind of jobs do you think you would have to do?
