	Research and find on a map countries where interesting fossils have been found.	Write a poem or a song describing our topic.	Imagine you have been on a fossil hunt. Write a diary entry or story about your adventure.
	Create a dinosaur menu. Think about the different types of dinosaurs and what they would like to eat (herbivores, carnivores) Be as creative as you can!	Visit your local library and find some non-fiction books about dinosaurs. If you cannot get to a library, research on the internet or Espresso.	Make up your own dinosaur. Think of a name, appearance, personality. Create a poster describing this dinosaur.
	Find or write some dinosaur jokes and share them with friends and family.	Do some research and find out which dinosaurs were the smallest, tallest, heaviest etc	Write some dinosaur word problems. (If a dinosaur has 2 legs, how many legs do 5 dinosaurs have?)
