## Aims

At Maltese Road we know that RE plays an important role in preparing pupils for adult life. In EYFS, RE is taught using RE related early learning goals, whilst in KS1 and KS2 our curriculum follows the Essex Agreed Syllabus, which has been broken down and divided for each year group.
